**NOTIFICATION**

As recommended by the 102<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Under Graduate Board, Dibrugarh University held on 17.03.2010, the 94<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Academic Council, Dibrugarh University held on 29.03.2010 *vide* Resolution No. (10) has approved withdrawal of the Notification circulated *vide* Memo No. DU/DR-A/8-1/08/2439 dated 28.02.2008, which had incorporated the following provision in the Dibrugarh University Regulations for the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Three Year Degree Course:

***The result of a candidate who fails to appear in any paper(s) of any of the Part I/Part II/Part III Examination of the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Three Year Degree Course shall be declared as incomplete and the absentee candidate shall have to appear in all the papers of the examination in the next legitimate chance(s);***

***Provided that a candidate who fails to appear in not more than two papers in an examination because of genuine extraordinary circumstances may be considered by the Vice Chancellor to be permitted to appear in the paper(s) as backlog(s) subject to submission of a certificate of genuineness from the Principal of the College concerned within 20 days from the date of the examination concerned. Provided further that the absentee students shall have to report the matter to the college immediately and delayed reporting will not be considered.***

The same resolution of the 94<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council has approved incorporation of the following provision in the Dibrugarh University Regulations for the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Three Year Degree Course:

***The Candidates who have failed or have been absent in not more than two papers of the Part I/Part II/Part III Examination of the B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Three Year Degree Course shall be allowed to appear in the next legitimate chance(s) as backlog.***

The above shall com into immediate effect.
